The Dutch institute researches aquatic issues in developing countries and emerging economies, promotes knowledge transfer in these regions and contributes to the training of local aquatic professionals. Janet Hering's research is partly concerned with biogeochemical cycles of trace elements in water, technologies for cleaning polluted drinking water and the management of aquatic resources and water infrastructure.
