For example, he has demonstrated how random molecular processes in a genetically homogeneous group of bacteria can give rise to diversification, which is directly relevant to our understanding of pathogenic bacteria. As a professor at ETH Zurich and department head at Eawag, Martin Ackermann achieves a productive combination of pure and applied research.
