Call for abstracts

The first ETH Domain Conference “Social Sciences on Environment, Technology & Sustainability” is taking place on Monday, January 27, 2025, at Eawag. The one-day conference provides a unique platform for fostering exchange among social scientists dealing with the broad, interrelated, and interdisciplinary topics of environment, technology, and sustainability. It is a great opportunity to discuss and get feedback on current work, and network with colleagues at the schools or institutes of the ETH domain. The conference will include “traditional” sessions for presenting research and getting questions and comments, some more interactive sessions, and of course coffee breaks and an apéro.

Parallel conference sessions will be organized around broad themes (climate, biodiversity, energy, resources, cities, etc.), disciplinary profiles, and crosscutting themes (teaching, outreach, etc.). We will also have a “RRR” poster session (Reuse or recycle an old poster to reduce waste and workload) for which we invite you to bring your poster from an older conference, so people learn also about your former work. A more detailed program will follow.

With this call, we invite you to submit a short abstract on your research and register for the conference. Unless we have clear doubts in terms of fit, we try to accommodate all presentations. The goal is to create an open platform for exchange. Participation is free of charge. Participation without a presentation is also possible.
