TRX Central Europe AG was founded in November 2000 as a Joint Venture between TRX Inc., USA, Hogg Robinson Plc., UK and Kuoni Travel Holding AG, Switzerland, the latter being the majority shareholder. Its purpose is to offer the travel trade technology and support services to support the growing Internet market. The Joint Venture included the German, Swiss and Austrian Markets and aimed at introducing a completely new suite of products in Europe. When leaving the company, the number of employees in the fulfilment- and support centres in Berlin, Zurich and Paris amounted to 250 people and the four biggest European Online Travel Agencies were TRX clients.
